It has particular regard for those people who are vulnerable or experiencing disadvantage. Its work draws on the view of today's seniors and on their concerns for future generations.

- Develop and formulate policy positions to present to governments
- Promote active ageing and a positive image of ageing
- Advocate on behalf of all older people
- Provide assistance to seniors who seek re-employment
- Collect, interpret and provide information to individuals
